Awards: No medals will be awarded, however the winning team will receive a token prize.

Entry: To secure a place a club representative should pay the entry fee by bank transfer. Confirmation of your club's place will be by email.

Bar services: Available in the club house from 12.00 noon.

Food: The entry fee includes soup and roll.

Smoking: Smokers please smoke in the area behind the waiting line but not smoke in the car park. Please dispose of cigarette ends responsibly and not on the grass. No smoking is allowed in the clubhouse.

Dogs: Sorry no dogs are allowed at the venue.

Closing date: Sunday 8th March.

Entry rules:

1. This is an inter-club competition for Berkshire clubs. All members of the Club Team must be members of a Berkshire Club and must be affiliated to Berkshire Archery Association. Associated club members may shoot for a Club Team.
2. A 'Club Team' will consist of three archers: two recurve, one barebow or Longbow. Teams may be male or female and can be seniors or juniors.
3. Three dozen arrows will be shot outdoors at a distance of 30 metres on an 80cm face, only tens count as golds.
4. Details will be single details with 3 archers per target boss.
5. Six (6) sighters will be allowed.
