

BAA Top Club Awards

These awards (one for Seniors and one for Juniors*) are to be used to drive an initiative or to achieve a particular objective. The awarding criteria will have a narrow focus that will help the initiative or deliver the objective.

For 2018, the initiative/objective will be: “Increasing Participation in the County Organisation and Administration” with the aim of increasing attendance at county meetings and volunteering to help at county events.

For 2018 the criteria will be:

- a) Attendance at committee meetings and the AGM.
 1. Attendance will be recorded by the meeting secretary and published in the official meeting minutes.

- b) Volunteering to assist with the county outdoor and indoor championships
 1. This will entail a minimum of two hours on any one calendar half-day for an adult and one hour for a junior.
 2. Archers taking part in the events will be included only if they have provided assistance either before or after their event session.
 3. The Tournament Organiser will notify the secretary of the names of those who provided assistance and their associated club. Note that these volunteers may be the family and friends of BAA members and will be “associated” to that member’s club

- c) Officers of the BAA are excluded from the above, but their family members or friends may be included.

* We realise that for juniors it will be difficult for them to attend a committee meeting (late in the evening on school nights) and difficult for them to volunteer (without their parents). But there are many ways they can help on the day of the event, e.g. score runners, raffle ticket sellers, field set up or change over, write up a blog of the event for BAA website /Facebook.
